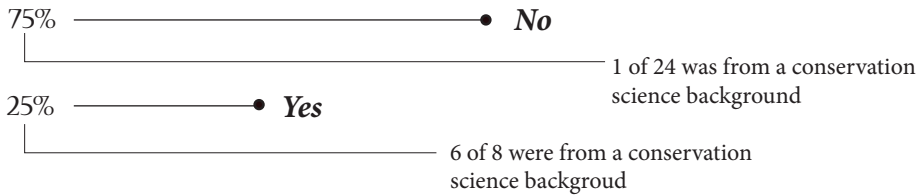


Have you heard of Anthropocene?



Scientists say that we are now in the **Anthropocene**.

So what is Anthropocene?
